IIMC-Team in Response to COVID-19 Locked Down & Super Cyclone - AmPhan, March-June'202

20th March - We all are overwhelmed with the Corona Virus Pandemic. The world slowly shutting down, in the mean time I have cancelled my all international conferences. We all are in Panic, however I am sure this situation will be over soon and everything will be OK. In the mean time we have prepared one short pictorial report on our Dhaki Campus, which I have attached with this message, please go through it and keep in touch always.

24th March - Our Globe is confronting with an Unfamiliar Bug, we have no Vaccine, no Medicines, our Body and Immune System does not know how to manage it. To overcome this Critical, Catastrophic Situation Only the Remaining option is not to be infected. Let us all Stay at Home, let's not meet the Bug-COVID-19, let's do not become Infected, Govt has officially declared 100% Locked Down. Our IIMC Projects will remain closed till further notice. Let's stay safe and I believe, surely we shall beat this Virus soon.

26th March - Let's make Strong Isolation, Social Distancing, and staying at Home is better than staying in the Hospital. We need to Beat the Bug, Prevention and Public Health is the Answer, Till we get a Proper Specific Vaccine. "Stay in Precautions to Stay Healthy"

30th March - We know, all Medicos are working hard in the Hospital, please keep it on. Church, Mosques, Temples are closed, Universities, Colleges, Schools are off, World is shutting down their Doors - Airports. The Doctors made Modern Temples - HOSPITAL will remain open. God in form of Doctors is working 24x7. Thank you all for taking care of Mankind and soon, we shall overcome this catastrophic situation.

4th April - We know "Small is Beautiful" and now we are learning "the Smallest is the Most Powerful". Our country has decided 100% Locked Down for next 3 weeks. Today I visited Prof. Chowdhury Sir and Rathin Das, most senior friends of our IIMC Mission. I joined in KPC Hospital to give inspirational and motivational Orientation and over all I have decided to be available if any of our IIMC members need any support. I'm medical doctor, I have a car and I can drive, please don't hesitate, let me know if anyone needs support. If it required we shall form IIMC Support Team, for community service. Take good care of yourself. This critical period will be over soon.

5th April - After 10 days 100% locked down in India, especially in rural areas, Social, Medical & Nutritional everything is reaching in a critical stage. We IIMC Team have decided to support as much possible Medically, Socially and Emotionally. Next Days we shall reach around 200 rural poor and destitute families with Rice, Lentils, Potatoes, Soybean, Sugar, Biscuits, Soap, Sanitizer, Medicaments and other Essential Materials. Any support and contribution will be very helpful. We shall keep you informed and updated regularly. Thank you very much for being with us every time.

8th April - We the Homo-Sapiens are in the War with a Virus. This moment we are so helpless and to Save Ourselves we need to hide in the Confinement of our Home. The Mankind so powerful, but so Vulnerable to a sub-microscopic organism. We are super intelligent, we have Supersonic Fighter, Rocket, Satellite, Atomic Bomb, but we don't know how to handle an Inferior Sub Biological Element. We are not yet Enough Clever......!













10th April - IIMC Members and Volunteers, Shopping in Whole Sale Market and Preparing Food Packages for Poor and Destitute Families in response to covid-19. Crisis and 100% Locked Down.

12th April - Final packet is ready with 9 items. Rice, Dal, Soya Chunk, Potatoes, Onion, Muri, Sugar, Biscuits, Detol, Soap. Someone has Corona Mask, someone no, but Hunger is there. IIMC Volunteers Team will bring Food for those Mothers and Children.

14th April - During this Corona Pandemic, IIMC volunteers and Medical Teams are ready to support any vulnerable, and needy people, we shall bring Sanitizer, Mask, Hand Gloves, Soap, Essential Medicines etc. and even our love and compassion. Please let us know if there is someone requires this help around you. However there is no reason to be in panic, we believe soon we shall come out of this unwanted situation. Please stay at home and isolated, if required surely we shall come to you.

Home Confinement, Yes we shall stay at home, but our commitments are to be near to the needy people. In these days our Concern is our Schools Children, our Orphanages, Disabled Children, Sponsored Children, Outdoors, Indoors, attending sick mothers and children, most of them are from simple background, we all are dependent to each other, but locked down at home, nearly non productive. Our IIMC mission is not equipped enough to fight against Corona Virus, this Bug is very delicate and crucial; our love and humanitarian approach does not influence it. We all are in the pain and in turmoil not being able to be near the people medically. For the greater interest we shall bear it and as soon war is end with Victory, we shall do all our best and shall try to recover all the loss and damages.

17th April - We IIMC Team has decided to support as much possible Medically, Socially and Emotionally. Next Days we shall reach poor and destitute families with Rice, Lentils, Potatoes, Soybean, Sugar, Biscuits, Soap, Sanitizer, Medicaments and other Essential Materials. We shall keep everyone and our all collaborators informed and updated regularly. Thank you very much for being with us every time.

19th April - These are the Materials will go in the Package, for poor, destitute, and daily floating labours who lives on Hands to Mouth, during the COVID -19, Pandemic Crisis. In the 1st phase -We are preparing for 500 Families. According to farther need, we shall be ready to do more. Thank you very much for your generous intentions to make contribution. We shall keep you updated regularly on this support works.

23rd April - 10 IIMC Volunteers Team including Barnali are Preparing 500 Food and Essentials Commodities Packages to distribute among Families of Daily Floating Labours, who is not able to work, because of 100% locked down. We thank you very much for your support.

25th April - Today IIMC, Organised 3 different Teams, Morning 1st Team Covered 100 Urban Destitute HIV affected families, 2nd team covered 160 Rural families, 3rd Team afternoon covered 150 families, Distributing Foods and Essential Commodities. We shall continue this Service, and want to Thank Everyone Joining, Contributing and Participating with us.













28th April - In Response to COVID –19 and 100 % Locked Down, Dr. Brahmochary with his IIMC Team, Local Leaders, MLA, and Police Authority organised Food and Essential Commodities Distribution among the families of Daily Workers, Floating Labours and Destitute. 150 families got food and other essential materials. Reported by IIMC Youth council News Bureau.

30th April - Today IIMC Team organised to distribute Food Packages among Educational Sponsorship Children and Families. Most of the families of our sponsored children are living in Below Poverty Line. Because of long Period Locked Down, Everyone is struggling and Suffering. We shall continue to support every children and family and hope soon this catastrophic COVID crisis is over. Thank you all for your support and contribution to overcome this unfortunate incident of Corona Virus attack.

Giving food to a poor mother is not doing a favour to her. It is an opportunity for us, and shall do it with pleasure.

2nd May - IIMC - Sewing Unit and Women Cooperative Producing Corona Virus Protection Mask. We shall distribute among Mothers, Children, Sponsorship Students and to others.

On response to COVID-19, Crisis, we identified some very special cases and families, who need special care and rehabilitation support.

4th May - In our IIMC Mission, Schools, Health Centres, Mothers Banks all are Under Locked Down, Poors, Destitutes, Daily Labours have no work, have no Foods. We are organising regular food distribution among 150 -160 families. Today it was at our Hogalkuria Centre. Thank you all supporting and joining us.

6th May - Today IIMC Team, Distributed Food Packages among very Poor Families of Sponsorship Children at Challapara-Kheadha. Most of them are not eating 2 meals in a day, Families are Locked at Home, no work, no money, no food, IIMC Members will try to bring food for everyone. Please forward to every sponsorship parents, and thank you all for taking care of everything.

8th May - During this Corona Pandemic, IIMC volunteers and Medical Teams are ready to support any vulnerable, and needy people, We shall bring Sanitizer, Mask, Hand gloves, Soap, essential Medicines etc. and even our love and compassion. Please let us know if there is someone requiring this help around you. However there is no reason to be in panic, we believe soon we shall come out of this unwanted situation. Please stay at home and isolated, if required surely we shall come to you.

11th May - In Rural areas daily workers can't work, no money to buy food. Today IIMC Team brought Food Packages to Village Mothers and to IIMC Women Peace Council Poor Members.700 Rural Villages Mothers are Member of our IIMC - Women Peace Council, they have a little business with our Micro Credit loan, which is no more active because of 100% Locked Down, most of them were living on their Daily Earning - "Hands to Mouth". They are suffering the most and even have

no 2 meals in a day, We IIMC Team have decided to help them as much possible with Food and Essential Materials for this vulnerable period.

We all hope this Catastrophic Crisis Period will be over soon, everyone will in normal life. Thank you all for your contribution during this difficult time.

12th May - In Rural areas daily workers can't work, no money to buy food. Today IIMC Team brought the Food Packages to Village Mothers and to IIMC Women Peace Council Poor Members. Giving food to a poor mother is not doing a favour to her. It is an opportunity for us, and shall do it with pleasure.















15th May - Rural Mothers and Children, waiting for a Meal. 4 Weeks 100% locked down, no work, no food at home. We IIMC Team, doing our best to distribute Food Packages among them. Thank you everyone for your Donation and Contribution during this Catastrophic Crisis Period.

16th May - Churches, Mosques, Temples are closed, Universities, Colleges, Schools are off, World has shut down the doors, Doctors made Modern Temple-Hospitals will remain open, God in the form of Doctors are working 24x7 to save lives. Medical Scientist are in war with a sub-microscopic organism for months. In India we are in 100% locked down for last 7 weeks. People are suffering, struggling and Starving, we in our IIMC Mission, everyday serving food and essential commodities among poor and destitute families who was living on daily work. Now the Tiring Locked Down will over with the winning of war.



17th May –Locked down has been extended till 31st May, with some relaxation. We shall continue our support services, when situation will improve, we shall organize Social and economical rehabilitation according to the situation appears.



18th May - Today we shall distribute Food Packages among 150 - 160 families around Garia Rail Line, living on daily labours, hand to mouth, poor and destitute people. Police administration, people's representatives, local authorities and IIMC Team will organise the distribution around 5 pm. We all are grateful and thankful to our all donors.





20th May - We shall be facing a drastic Cyclonic Storm, "AmFan" will hit on 20th around Dhaki Campus, Gangetic Delta and all Bengal, with 150 - 180 km speed wind and heavy rain fall. How to manage, COVID attack, locked down, social distance and last 2 months people have no work no food. Let's Cross the Fingers and hope everything will be OK.





21st May - Super Cyclone "AmPhan" damaged houses, Trees, Electricity, Roads, and Everything. It will take months to recover. In our IIMC Indoor Roof of Handlooms Centre is

flown over. Challapara School is Shelter Camp for many Poor Families. COVID19, Locked Down, and Cyclonic Storm, very unfortunate incidents. We all IIMC Volunteers are doing our best to support everyone. Thank you very much for your continuous Supports, Promotions and Encouragements

22nd May - Super Cyclone "AmPhan" flown away over Gangetic Delta and Kolkata, wind speed 130 - 140 km/hr. (less than the forecast), most of the muddy and bamboo houses are destroyed, 300000 people were evacuated, good preparation, however 98 people died. Many families lost houses are in shelter in our IIMC School. We shall take care of them. Super Cyclone "AmPhan" damaged houses, Trees, Electricity, Roads, and Everything. It will take months to recover. In our IIMC Indoor Roof of Handlooms Centre is flown over. Challapara School is Shelter Camp for many Poor Families. COVID19, Locked Down, and Cyclonic Storm, very unfortunate incidents. We all IIMC Volunteers are doing our best to support everyone. Thank you very much for your continuous Supports, Promotions and Encouragements.



25th May - AmPhan - Super Cyclone damaged more than we predicted. We are receiving more information on the damage. Most of the Muddy and Bamboo Houses are Destroyed in southern Bengal and around Kolkata. Electric poll, Trees even Human Death Bodies are obstructing roads. COVID19, Locked Down, no working possibility and now Sup er Cyclone, Poor people are 100% Destitute, no



food, no shelter, starvation and struggling for surviving. We IIMC Volunteers Team will do our best to support everyone around us. Thank you all for your continuous promotion, support and inspiration to us.

1st June - COVID19, Locked-down, No-Work, No Cash, Market, Grocery, Vegetables, Lives, everything was in Turmoil and now AmPhun Super Cyclone..!!!

We know Nature is how Powerful --, village after village washed away, Roads are now River, above all 2 questions - Corona Vaccines and Electricity, when will be available..??? God will not help us, it's done by Him. Let's blame the Nature and we are part of it. Administration trying to help, World Community, Stand with us. Mobile without charge, grocery, vegetables are rotten in the freezer. We in IIMC Campus still have some rotten food, but around our neighbourhood, especially in Dhaki and Coastal area many are not eating a meal....??? Lives must go on....... Everything will soon over in a coming morning with the raising Sun.



4th June - COVID19, 100% Locked Down, Super Cyclone AmPhan, all these together Triple attacks, people around Kolkata and Bengal, specially poorer section went down to destitute and homeless. We in our IIMC volunteers Team trying our best to support everyone around us with food packages, rehabilitation, medical, mental and social cares. We shall continue this support. Thank you all for your continuous promotion and inspiration to us.



10th June - Super Cyclone AmPhan damaged several IIMC Centres. Reconstruction going on in Dhaki campus, it will take some months to recover, however everything will be OK soon. Thank you very much for your support, contribution and all the inspiration to us.

15th June - Today IIMC Team organised to distribute Food Packages among Educational Sponsorship Children and Families. Most of the families of our sponsored children are





living in Below Poverty Line. Because of long Period Locked Down, Everyone is struggling and Suffering. We shall continue to support every children and family and hope soon this catastrophic COVID crisis is over. Thank you all for your support and contribution to overcome this unfortunate incident of Corona Virus attack.

20th June - Today was Stormy Rainy Day, very hard time for Homeless People, we tried to do our best and distributed Food Packages among 160 poor Mothers.

 23^{rd} June –Today we all IIMC Team are in Maipith - Debipur, in Coastal area of J - plot, Dhaki, Distributing food Packages among AmPhan affected families. Super Cyclone has destroyed houses, Trees, Crops, most of the Coastal people are now Destitute. We IIMC Relief Team trying our best to



supply food packages and essential materials everyday among 150 - 200. Thank you very much for your continuous supports and inspirations to us.

27th June –Today IIMC Team organised Food Packages, distribution among Super Cyclone AmPhan, affected poor and destitute families in Pathankhali, Gosaba Island, Sundarban. 200 families received Food and Essential Materials. Thanks to our all collaborators for the Generous Contribution.



30th June –Locked Down slowly relaxing People are looking forward to join in life, Monsoon rain, showering time to time, our IIMC indoor campus is more Green and blooming. Tomorrow 1st July IIMC volunteers Team will start regular activities and our IIMC-Mission will remain open every day.
